Lodge Repairs - A great deal of work has been done to the Lodge to take care of some long needed repairs. The rear metal roof and all guttering over the kitchen was replaced. Windows in the Lodge Hall were removed and restoration work was done to the windows and frames. The windows were returned and are now protected by storm windows. A deadbolt was installed on the rear kitchen door and all locks in the Lodge were re-keyed so that only one key is needed for all doors. An electric heater in the kitchen area was replaced. New shutters were installed in the anti room and Lodge Hall to replace the old blue curtains. A new gas heater will soon be installed in the anti room to replace the old one which does not work and can no longer be repaired. A sinkhole appeared in the rear parking lot over the Town Run. Extensive excavating work was performed by Shepherd University, as the damage was on their property. The area was repaired and cleared for several new Handicapped parking spaces, which can be used by all.
